Prop A - School Bonds

sf.citi supports improvements towards the San Francisco Unified School District to help ensure a quality learning environment and successful future for all children.

Prop B - City College Parcel Tax

sf.citi supports the education-to-workforce pipeline through strengthening affordable college education and job readiness training.

Prop C - Loans to Finance Acquisition and Rehabilitation of Affordable Housing

sf.citi supports the expansion of funds to increase permanent affordable housing in San Francisco.



Prop D - Vacancy Appointments

sf.citi does not support efforts to limit Mayoral oversight of high-level appointments to key positions within City Hall.

Prop G - Police Oversight

sf.citi supports this proposition to expand police accountability and create more robust community safety standards for San Franciscans.



Prop H - Public Advocate

sf.citi does not support the creation of the Office of the Public Advocate. This divisive and costly proposition fails to address key city issues such as homelessness and transportation and creates unnecessary bureaucratic barriers.

Prop I - Funding for Seniors & Adults with Disabilities

sf.citi supports this proactive proposition to provide stability and support to seniors and adults with disabilities.

Prop J - Funding for Homelessness and Transportation

sf.citi supports the creation of a targeted fund towards improving services for homelessness and transportation issues in San Francisco.



Prop K - General Sales Tax

sf.citi supports the modest increase of the general sales tax to help fund homelessness and transportation priorities guaranteed by Proposition J, its companion measure. If passed, this tax will be a lower sales tax than many Bay Area counties and cities.



Prop L - MTA Appointments and Budget

sf.citi does not support the ammendment to SFMTA Board appointment procedures. This proposition will curb the effectiveness and efficiency of the Mayor's oversight.



Prop M - Housing & Development Commission

sf.citi does not support the creation of the Housing & Development Commission. This proposition puts further unnecessary bureaucratic barriers in place towards building housing and promoting economic development.



Prop O - Office Development in Candlestick Point and Hunters Point

sf.citi supports this proposition to expand commercial development and encourage company growth in underdeveloped areas of San Francisco.



Prop Q - Prohibiting Tents on Public Sidewalks

sf.citi supports this proposition to provide long-term solutions to the homelessness crisis through transitioning those in need from living in tents to stable housing and accessible shelters.



Prop R - Neighborhood Crime Unit

sf.citi supports this measure to improve neighborhood crime prevention and public safety within the San Francisco Police Department and prioritize enforcement of quality of life laws in our neighborhoods.



Prop U - Affordable Housing Requirements for Market-Rate Development Projects

sf.citi supports this effort to increase the inclusion of middle-income residents for affordable housing eligibility.



Prop X - Preserving Space for Neighborhood Arts, Small Businesses and Community Services in Certain Neighborhoods

sf.citi does not support this proposition to place restrictions on the re-use of production/distribution/repair (PDR) space, which will limit the growth and success of small businesses in the Mission and SoMa neighborhoods.



Prop RR - BART Safety, Reliability and Traffic Relief

sf.citi supports the expansion of funds available to improve public transportation and traffic issues in San Francisco.
